If you're feeling energetic, head for the hills by Kyleakin (Kie-ack-in) to enjoy the network of trails and spectacular hilltop views. Keep your eyes peeled for all kinds of marine wildlife at Kylethera (Kie-ray) and explore life in the woods abandoned village of Leitir Fura (Lee-cheer foo-ra).

Welcome to the Kyleakin and Kinloch Hills

The Leitir Fura Trail

It's well worth following the trail along the coast from Kinloch to the abandoned village of Leitir Fura.

This used to be a busy, well-connected place, right beside the well-trodden drovers' route to Kylerhea. Once home to around a dozen families, during the 19th century people gradually drifted away.

Enjoy dramatic sea views as you walk the lower track, or immerse yourself in the woodlands of the old drovers' path.

Follow our Marine Mammal Trail between Kylethera car park and the Otter Hide. In the shelter of the Otter Hide, you can investigate the wildlife and culture of the Kyle, whatever the weather.

At Kinloch you can find out how people managed the woodland as a valuable resource. You can explore the remains of the old farm at Kinloch, and listen to stories and songs of the people of the area at our Listening Post.




I'm lichen it!

The clean air and mild coastal climate create ideal conditions for all kinds of unusual lichens. On rocks and trees, look out for the leafy 'lungs' of the lungwort and the mysterious 'writing' of the script lichen.



There's so much to explore – on foot, by bike and through all your senses. Use this map to help you plan your visit.



Ceann Locha / Kinloch

Rùraich ann an tobhta an t-seann tuathanais. Èist ri fuaimnean Gàidhealach agus fosgail do shùilean ri saoghal coille an àite.

Explore the remains of the old farm, enjoy the sounds of Gaelic culture and open your eyes to life in the native woodland.



1 Slighe Leitir Fura / Leitir Fura Trail



Cuairt iongantach dhan bhaile-fearainn bhàn seo.

A dramatic circular walk to this abandoned farming village.

Fad-slighe iomlan: 8km / 5 miltean (cuairt)
Ùine thuairmseach: 2.5 uair

Cearcall nas giorra dhan chiad ionad-seallaidh: 4 km / 2.5 miltean (cuairt)
Ùine thuairmseach: 1 uair

Full trail length: 8 km / 5 miles (return)
Approx. time: 2.5 hours

Shorter loop to first viewpoint: 4 km / 2.5 miles (return)
Approx. time: 1 hour

Caol Àcain / Kyleakin

Slighean coille le seallaidhean drùidhteach bho mhullach Cnoc a' Mhadaidh-ruaidh. Chan eil mòran pàrcadh ann aig an ionad-tòiseachaidh, ach tha gu leòr ann ann an Caol Àcain.

Woodland trails with impressive views from the summit of Cnoc a' Mhadaidh-ruaidh - hill of the fox. Parking is limited at the starting point but there is plenty of parking in Kyleakin.

2 Slighe a' Chnuic / Cnoc Trail



Ceum morghain a chaid a thogail a dh'aona ghnòthach gu do thoirt suas gu cuairt-coise a' mhullaich agus ionadan-seallaidh.

A purpose-built gravel path that climbs steadily to reach the hilltop circular walk and viewpoints.

Fad-slighe: 2.3 km / 1.4 miltean
Ùine coisich thuairmseach: 40 mion

Trail length: 2.3 km / 1.4 miles
Approx. time: 40 mins

3 Slighe Anabhaig / Anavig Trail



Tha an cearcall seo a' lùbadh nas fhaide timcheall air a' chnoc tro choille gu ruige seallaidhean iongantach aig a' mhullach.

This longer loop leads round the hill through woodland to spectacular views from the top.

Fad-slighe: 3.5 km / 2.1 miltean
Ùine coisich thuairmseach: 1 uair

Trail length: 3.5 km / 2.1 miles
Approx. time: 1 hour

Caol Reatha / Kylerhea



Tòisich an seo airson Slighe Mamalan na Mara agus Falachan nam Biastan-dubha.

Your starting point for the Marine Mammal Trail and the way to the Otter Hide.

Look out for otters and other wildlife from the shelter of our wildlife viewing hide.

4 Slighe Mamalan na Mara / Marine Mammal Trail

An easy walk to the Otter Hide and back, along a good track through stunning coastal scenery.

Ùine thuairmseach: 30 mion




